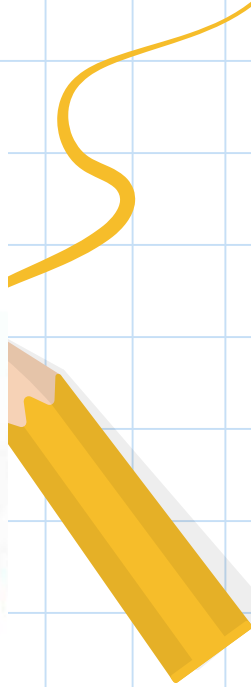

Mongolian family wearing "deel"



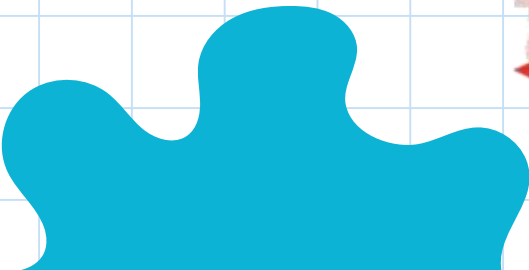
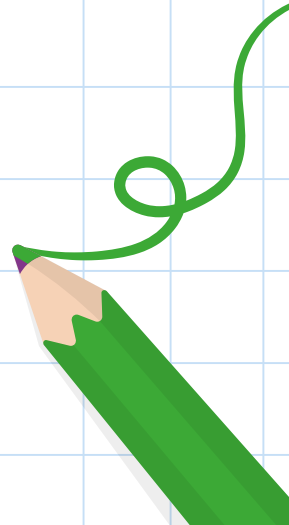
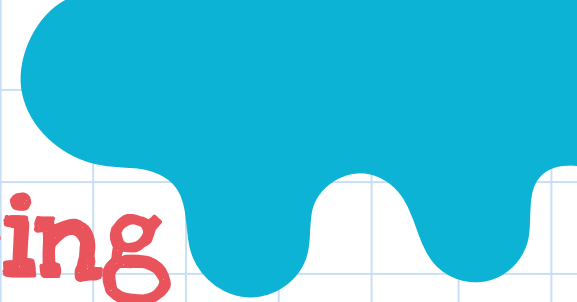
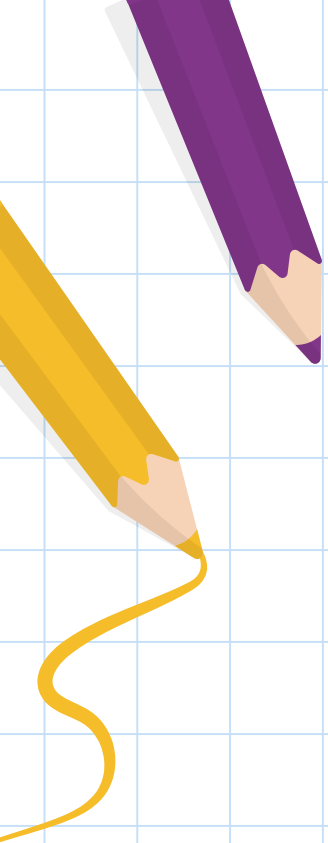
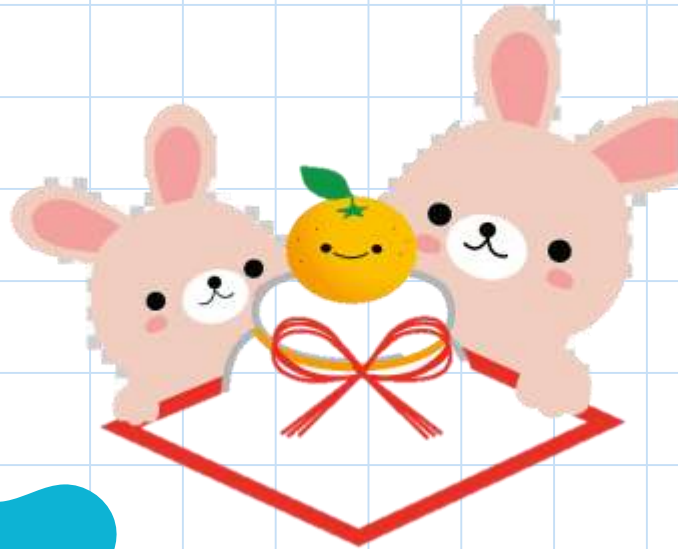
Deel looks more beautiful when you wear it with a hat called "malgai"

Naadam festival (July 11-15)



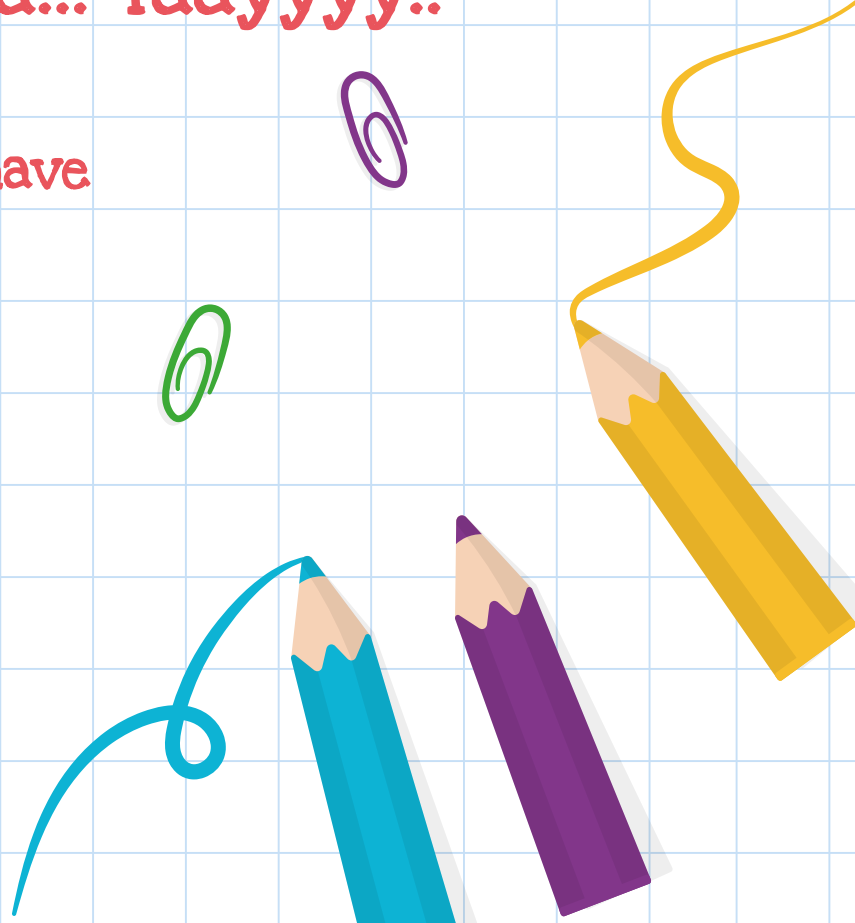
