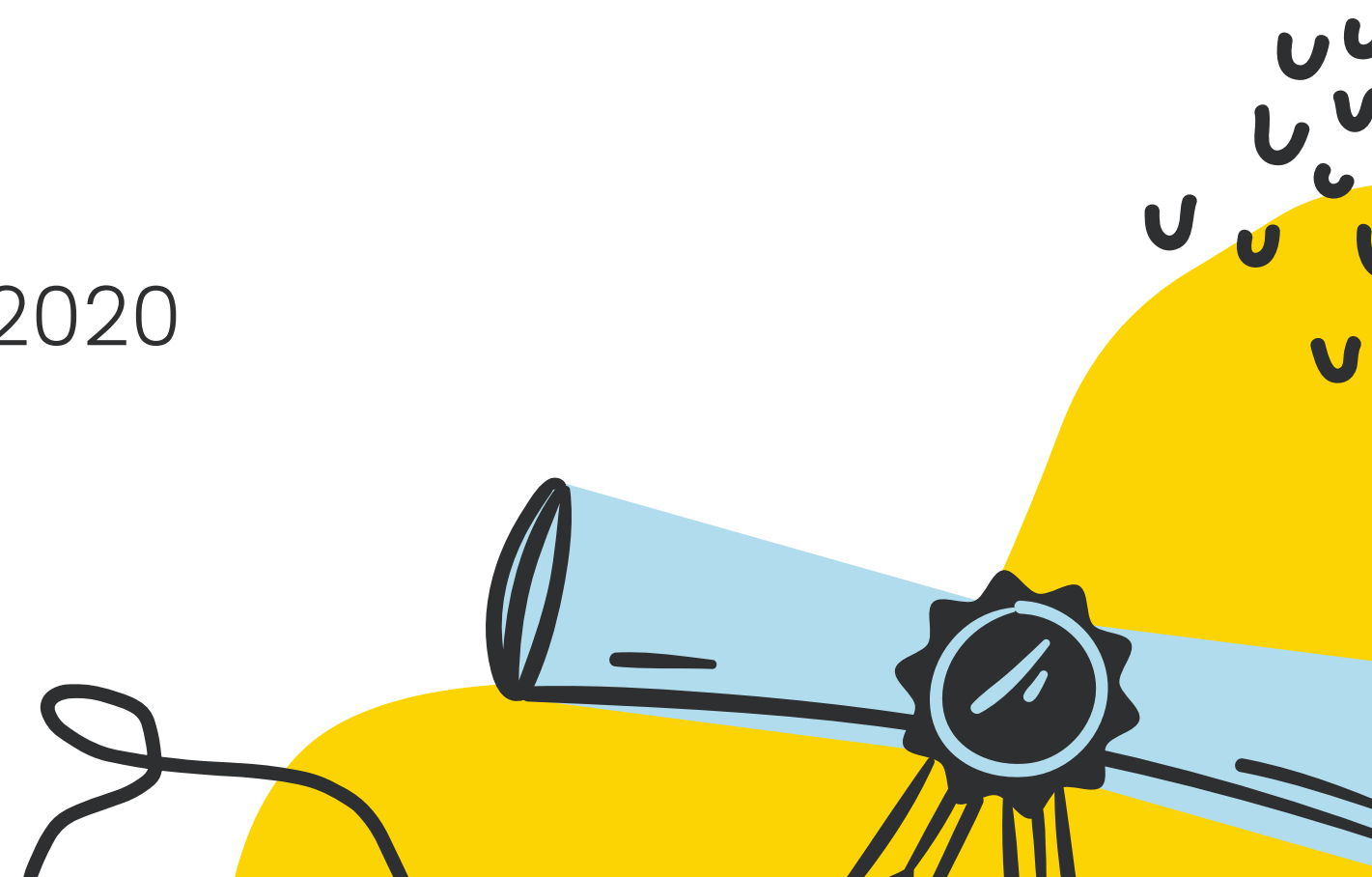

- Students get a 15 days holiday during this festival!

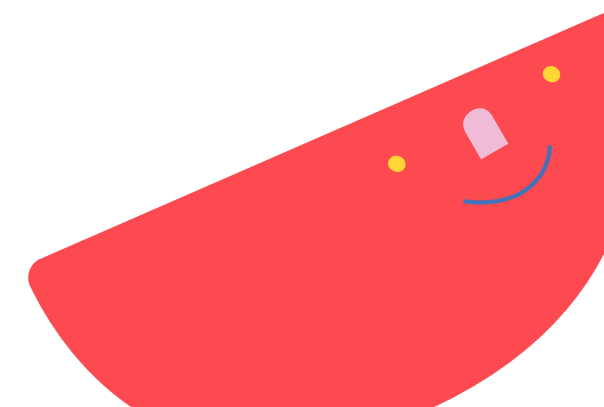
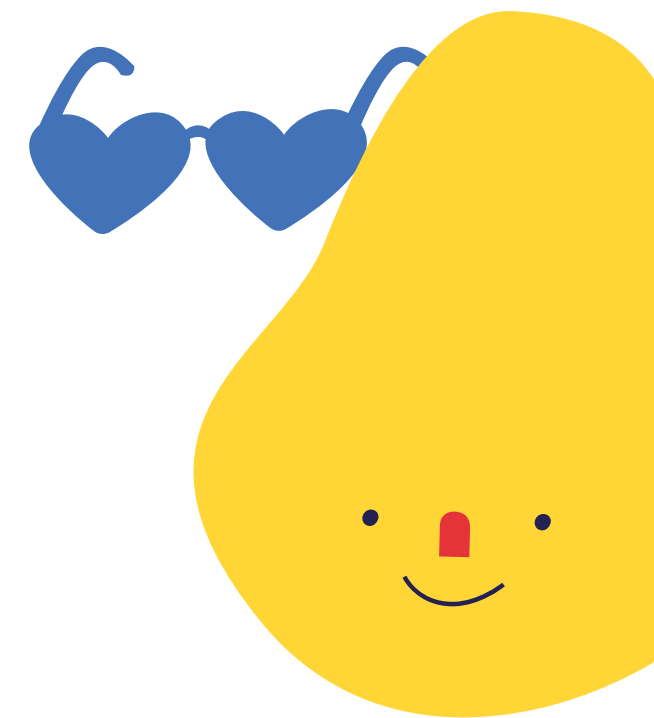




TIHAR

THE SECOND BIGGEST FESTIVAL OF NEPAL

- It is a 5 day festival where we celebrate different animals and people in our lives.
- It is also called 'the festival of lights' and is celebrated by Hindu people in Nepal.
- Students get 5 days holidays from school during Tihar!



DAY 1

- We worship **Crows & Ravens**
- We feed them seeds & grains
- Crows & Ravens are supposed to be the messenger of Death



DAY 2

- We worship Dog
- We feed them food & offer them garlands
- We thank them for their companionship, loyalty and service.





DAY 3

- We worship **Cow**
- Cow is a sacred animal for Hindu people in Nepal
- Cow is said to be the form of "**Goddess of wealth**"
- We feed cows food & offer them garlands
- We light up our homes on this day! (Just like Christmas!)





DAY 4

- We worship Ox
- We feed oxen food & offer them garlands
- Some people also do ceremonies where they worship themselves which is called "Mha Puja " or Self Worship



DAY 5

- We worship our **siblings**
- We celebrate the **bond between brothers and sisters**
- Brothers and sisters feed each other and give each other gifts
